REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING CALLED TO ORDER: Mayor Pierson declared a quorum present and opened the Regular City Council meeting at 7:00 p.m.

The following members of the City Council were present: Dale Sluder, Mike Wallace, Tammy Swaner and Payson Reese.

Others present were as follows: Dena Mabbutt, Clerk/Treasurer; Cliff Katona, Police Chief.

Members of the public were: Kevin Johnston

Mayor Pierson led the Council and audience in the Pledge of Allegiance.

CORRECTIONS TO AGENDA: none

PUBLIC COMMENT TIME: none

MINUTES: Mayor Pierson asked for corrections or additions to the minutes of November 7, 2017. There were none. Motion made by Councilwoman Swaner to accept the minutes as presented. Councilman Reese seconded the motion, all in favor, no opposition. Motion passed unanimously.

VOUCHERS FOR PAYMENT: The Council reviewed the vouchers for payment. Councilman Sluder moved to approve all of the claims and payment thereof as presented. Councilman Wallace seconded the motion. All in favor, no opposition. Motion passed unanimously.

REPORTS ON MEETINGS: Dena Mabbutt talked about the SIEDO meeting she attended in Burley on November 16, 2017.

BUSINESS:

RESOLUTION APPOINTING CITY CLERKS AS FLOOD PLAIN ADMINISTRATORS: Mayor Pierson advised that he has spoken with our attorneys and they don't want to write a resolution that is contrary to the ordinance. They will write a memorandum which will work.

CHICKEN ORDINANCE UPDATE: Mayor Pierson said he had heard from Clarissa Granquist about the chicken ordinance again and asked the council what they wanted to do. Discussion about a chicken ordinance ensued and included Mr. Johnston. Councilman Sluder suggested that we do nothing at this time as we don't have a problem with chickens in town. The rest of the council agreed, however there was no motion, second or vote.

POLICE OFFICE CARPET BID: Chief Katona has a bid from Bozzuto's for new carpet for the police office of **\$1,935.00**. Councilman Sluder made a motion to go ahead and get the carpet. The motion was seconded by Councilman Wallace. All in favor, no opposition. Motion passed.

CHRISTMAS BONUSES: Employee Christmas bonuses were discussed. Councilwoman Swaner made a motion to do the same as we did last year. Councilman Reese seconded the motion. All in favor, no opposition. Motion passed.

CORRESPONDENCE: Mayor Pierson read a letter from Maureen O'Shea from IDWR that we have completed our Community Assistance Visit requirements. Also, Mayor Pierson read letters he is sending to two young men who have completed their Eagle Scout requirements.

ADJOURN: Councilman Reese moved to adjourn. Councilman Sluder seconded the motion. All in favor, no opposition. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 7:34 p.m.
