Amendments to Agenda: None


Sign Permit Application: Chairman Marsh asked if everyone had a chance to look at the sign permit for Farmhouse Grocery. There was a little discussion about which sign they were updating. After discussion Commissioner Brass made a motion to approve the sign permit application. Commissioner Schoolcraft seconded the motion. All in favor, motion passed.

Discussion on finding new planning and zoning members: There was discussion on needing to find a few new planning and zoning commission members, since we have been having a hard time having a quorum for meeting and because Commissioner Schoolcraft will be temporarily away for about 3 months. Commissioner Chuck Rutler has already said in the past that we can replace him due to the fact that he is out of town working most of the time. There were several names mentioned of people who might be interested and we need to follow up with them. Planning and Zoning Administrator, Jennifer Rumble, told the Planning and Zoning Commission that she plans on attending a City Council meeting to let them know how much they have been struggling to meet the quorum requirements for the monthly meetings.

Discussion on existing members terms: There are a few Planning and Zoning Commissioners whose terms have expired or are expiring soon. Commissioner Wallace would like to renew his term. It is expired. Commissioner Vasquez would like to renew his term as well. It expires at the end of this year. Commissioner Brass term has expired but says she will stay on the board until a replacement can be found. She is the area of impact commissioner and will need to be appointed again by the County. Commissioner Wallace and Commissioner Vasquez will need to be appointed again by the Mayor.
